Charter Petition Revision Support Material

On Tuesday, January 14, 2025 at 6:00pm, our Board of Education will review the petition revision changes that we submitted in November of 2024. We want to provide brief highlights of these requested changes:

- We are requesting to have an autonomous budgeting structure
 - Did you know that there are 47 charter schools in Orange County and that we are the only charter school that doesn't have an autonomous budget structure. Our request to have an autonomous budget structure is in alignment with how charter schools operate.
- Given the laws of California, if a charter has an autonomous budget structure, this requires an autonomous governance structure as well
 - A governing board member of the PYLUSD Board of Education would have a seat on the Charter Board if this is approved

We want to ensure accuracy in the information that is being given to our community- these changes maintain our status as a PYLUSD school. In no way does this make our school an independent charter school. We remain a dependent charter school.
